
















Tip platform on its side and assemble Treated Ground Contact 4"x4" Legs (not included) into Leg Receivers so wood contacts bottom of Receiver. Secure with include ST6.3x40 Lag Bolts with steel washer as shown in Figure 11.

Follow all local building codes to safely build and erect wood tower structure, wood ladder / stairs and to anchor tower.

 4x4 Receiver Brackets are designed to fit Treated Ground Contact 4"x4" square lumber. Never use round or smaller lumber for leg construction. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death.
